Outdoor Skating Rinks to Open

Bismarck Parks and Recreation District will open four public outdoor skating rinks and warming houses on Saturday, December 17th.

The rinks and their addresses are:
Jaycee Centennial Park, Manitoba and Century Ave;
Municipal Ballpark, S. Washington St. and Sweet Ave.;
Tatley-Eagles Park, Michigan Ave. and Airport Rd.
VFW Family Recreational Park at Solheim School, 325 Munich Dr.

Due to flooding, there will be just one rink available this season at Solheim School. Lions Park and North Central Park outdoor rinks and warming houses will be open in the near future. The Tom O'Leary Sledding Hill will open when there is adequate snow.

The hours of the warming houses at the ice rinks are Monday through Friday, 3:30-9 pm; Saturdays and Sundays, 1-9 pm and on public school holidays, 1-9 pm. On Christmas Eve, December 24th, the hours for the warming houses are 11 am to 3 pm. The warming houses are closed on Christmas Day, December 25th.
