Answer the trail questions below...

1. (Tom O'Leary Trail) Take a diversion off the Tom O'Leary trail and head into the Bismarck Rotary Arboretum, right off of Ward Road and the golf course's 15th tee box. Wander along the path of the Arboretum. What is the name of the tree by marker number five?
2. (Capitol Grounds) Take a walk, spin or run through the trails on the grounds of the ND capital. There's a very large rock with a metal plaque that notes the placing of the capitol grounds on the Natural Area Registry in what month and year?
3. (North Washington Street) Change up the scenery. Explore the trail on N. Washington Street, north of Ash Coulee Road. It's a straight as an arrow trail, but has one bit of a turn. Be an artist and draw the yellow sign that designates the trail's small change in direction before it straightens out again.
4. (Burleigh Trail to Tavis Road) Somewhere along the trail (on the north side), you'll see a sign leaning up against a tree. What is the last word on this sign?
5. (Cottonwood Trail) Find an orange #2 painted on the trail. Stand on it facing south. What is the color of the structure you see?
6. (Tom O'Leary Trail) Somewhere along the trail, there was a tree planted by Daisy Troop No. 3194. What is the date this tree was planted?
7. (Sertoma Park) What date is carved into the concrete below the split level fence on the west end of the trail?
8. (Bill Mills Nature Trail) Identify the 2 animals on the Wetland Development sign along the trail.
9. (McDowell Dam) What type of dwelling is attached to a dog waste sign toward the end of the paved trail west of the parking lots.
10. (University Trail) The text "1 MILE" is painted on the trail someplace along the trail between United Tribes Technical College and 12th Street. Which direction does the text face?
