3. (Lions Park) Explore the new trail through Lions Park! As you wander along the trail next to East Avenue E, you'll see a memorial marker in honor of Bob Randall, a founder of the Bismarck Mandan Bird Club. The marker has a quote from William Wordsworth on it. What is the quote?
4. (Pioneer Park) Head south from Pioneer Park and you'll come to a bench overlooking the beautiful river bottoms just before the pet cemetery. The bench is set in concrete blocks. What date (year) is imprinted in the concrete near the leg of the bench?
5. (Riverwood Trail) Enjoy the forestry and winding trail along the south side of the Riverwood Trail. Tucked in the woods, you'll find a power box labeled, Meredith Cable. Which direction does the cable box lean?
