8:00 - 8:25 a.m. Check-in
8:30 - 9:25 a.m.

#121 **Music My Way** with Gwen Hall, Grades 3-6 – Students will create music using a variety of traditional and nontraditional instruments. Come ready to let your creative juices flow.
#531 **Art Explosion** with Ali LaRock, Grades K-2 – Young artists explore their creativity with an explosion of fun art materials, basic techniques and projects! Students will paint, sculpt, draw, glue and more during this exciting class. Please have your child wear an old shirt or paint smock to class.
#541 **Making Journals, Sketchbooks & Basic Drawing** with Paul Noot, Grades K-6 - The students will make journals and sketchbooks that they can use all week. Basic drawing techniques will also be taught.

9:30 - 10:25 a.m.

#122 **Sing, Dance, Play** with Gwen Hall, Grades K-2 – Students sing, dance and play a variety of music connected to children's literature. Come act out books and enjoy making music together.
#532 **Rockin' Turtles** with Rebecca Young-Sletten, Grades K-6 – Students will have fun turning rocks into cool turtles that will stretch their imaginations. They will be learning to paint, stamp and add textures to various rocks to make their turtles come alive!
#542 **Just Add Light** with Alicia Broxmeyer, Grades K-4 – Students will create projects around a theme of light. They will use light to create a print from photographic paper, create candles with ice, and surprise someone with an invisible drawing. They will also use light to create drawings from shadows and embellish a light switch plate with their original drawing
#525 **Don't Drink the Water**, Grades 4-6 – Water treatment plants must repeatedly test water to make sure it's drinkable. Become a chemist and perform the same tests on your own water, such as test for pH, hardness, iron and sulfate content, and more.

#524 **Smells like Fun!**, Grades K-2 – Play mystery games, do art projects, and other activities that engage all 5 senses in this fun-filled camp.
#533 **Fun with Sculpey Clay** with Ali LaRock, Grades 2-6 – Sculpey Clay is a soft polymer clay that comes in a variety of colors. Once molded it can be baked solid in a regular oven. This class will allow students to explore all the possibilities of this fun clay. They will learn basic building techniques in creating animals, small pots, people, and miniatures as well as more adventurous techniques in creating useable works of art with sculpey like pens, dice, and magnets.
#543 **Boxes and Pots** with Paul Noot, Grades K-6 – This is a basic clay class. Students will make boxes and other containers out of clay. The students will also get an opportunity to use the potter wheel.

#534 **Bird House with Textures** with Rebecca Young-Sletten, Grades 1-6 – Students learn to paint, print and add texture to unique birdhouses. Each student adds their own special personality to their bird house and bring home a very special bird house to add to the garden.
#544 **Painting From Nature** with Alicia Broxmeyer, Grades 2-6 – Students will use animals and the landscape as inspiration to create a watercolor resist painting and animal x-ray paintings. Watercolor techniques will be explored and students will study the work of Oljewe artist Norval Morrisseau.
#254 **Water Wonders**, Grades K-2 – What makes something float or sink? Kids will get a little wet while exploring the science of water.

#315 **A Week in Shade Tree Players**, Grades K-6 – This class will show you what it is like in a real children's theatre production; learning basics of the theatre, acting, movement, learning lines and playing theatre games!
#226 **Electrifying Experience**, Grades 3-5 – Have you ever wanted to build a burglar alarm? How about a radio? Learn how the electrical parts of these devices (and more) work by building them with safe component parts.
#535 **Misfit Toys – Creating Your Own Soft Plushies** with Ali LaRock, Grades 3-6 – Create cute or strange soft-stuffed toys with fabric, felt, stuffing, buttons, and other odds and ends. Students will learn some basic stitches and gluing techniques to create their own stuffed toys! Create animals, strange creatures, people, food with faces...the possibilities are endless.
#545 **Who Let the Animals Out?** with Paul Noot, Grades K-6 – Students will learn basic drawing techniques and how to draw animals the easy way. The class will look at textures and values to help their animals look 3-D. The class will also sculpt their animals using clay.

2:00 - 2:55 p.m.

#316 **Theatre Games**, Grades K-6 – Learning one of the most popular forms of theatre – Improv - can be a breeze, find out how with Shade Tree Players!
#226 **Acids & Bases**, Grades 4-6 – What happens when an acid is mixed with a base? What is pH anyway? Participants will do experiments that answer these questions, plus cause color changes, give off heat, and more!
#536 **Personalized Nature Aprons** with Rebecca Young-Sletten, Grades K-6 – Students have the fun opportunity to design unique designs to print and paint to their aprons which are tie-dyed first. Each student is given nature patterns to incorporate in their apron and make it special!
#546 **Just Add Water**, with Alicia Broxmeyer, Grades K-4 – Students will create various art projects with water, such as: summer snow globes, insoluble paintings, watercolor paintings, and lots of experimentation with watercolor techniques.

3:00 - 3:55 p.m.

#227 **Move It!**, Grades 2-4 – Will a heavy object fall faster than a light one? Try this experiment and more in this fun, hands-on class. Participants will experiment with things like sandpaper, scales, balls and more to discover how forces affect everything around us.
#537 **Drawing Cartoons and Comics**, with Ali LaRock, Grades 3-6 – Cartoons can be anything: people, animals, objects, or even food! Have fun and learn simple ways to create your own cartoon characters whether it is in a traditional cartooning style or the popular anime and manga styles. Learn how to create expressions, features, personalities, and add words and dialogue to your cartoon drawings. Use your characters in short comic strips and manga. Explore new techniques, a variety of art mediums, and have fun talking to others with the same interests.
#547 **Splash, Splatter & Spill** with Paul Noot, Grades K-6 – Let's splash and splatter outside the borders. Students will experiment with different types of paint and other materials. This is a great class for self-expression.

#408 **Activity Hour**, Grades K-6 – This hour will feature something different each day! Monday students will explore the exhibits at Gateway to Science. Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday they will join Theo Art School in "Pirates, Knights and Kings" where they will draw, paint and sculpt various art projects. Friday students will have the option of going over to the new BSC Aquatic & Wellness Center for some supervised swimming. So, bring your swimsuits on Friday! (If students do not wish to go swimming they are welcome to spend the hour at Gateway to Science.)

5:00 p.m. All activities are concluded. If desired, students can come into Gateway to Science after attending sessions (gallery hours Noon-7:00 p.m. Monday-Thursday and Noon-5:00 p.m. Friday). There is a \$2.00 per child/visit fee unless you are a Gateway to Science member.
