

COTTONWOOD PARK SOFTBALL COMPLEX 2008-2012

WHAT

The expansion to the complex at Cottonwood Park will include two 4-plex and one 2-plex softball field configurations as well as one field for ages 13 and above including high school and college baseball. Also included in the project are two concession stands, restrooms, maintenance building, playgrounds, picnic areas, and additional trails connecting to existing Cottonwood trails as well as Burleigh Avenue and 12th Street.

WHO

The Bismarck Parks and Recreation District has partnered with the Men's and Women's Softball Associations and the Bismarck Baseball Boosters to move this project forward. These groups have committed funds for support of the field development.

WHERE

Nearly 55 additional acres south of the existing Cottonwood Park have been acquired by the Bismarck Parks and Recreation District over the past three years to meet the park and recreation demands of a growing community.

WHY

The demand for game and practice fields is extremely high and currently there is a shortage of fields to serve that demand or grow the youth or adult programs. At this time, the softball associations are turning away teams for the lack of fields. The need also exists within the district for a regulation baseball field for older youth and college age players.

WHEN

The project is underway and has a completion date set for of 2012. Watch for the first fields opening for play in 2010.
