

HILLSIDE POOL & LIONS PARK RENOVATIONS 2008-2011

WHAT

The renovation of Lions Park/Hillside Pool will include improvements to all areas within the park as well as new additions. The new features will include three playgrounds, four picnic shelters, new trails, expanded skate park, improved roadways and expanded and reconfigured parking. The plan also includes the demolition of the 24-year-old waterslide, which has been completed, for public safety reasons. Renovation of the pool and bathhouse will be included in future phases of the redevelopment.

WHO

The Bismarck Parks and Recreation District has dedicated funds through its Improvement District and Capital Construction funds for the redevelopment of the park. Private funds will also be pursued through Lions Clubs, matching grants and other public and private sources for specific projects.

WHERE

The improvement to Lions Park are all inclusive throughout the entire park and includes trail connections to surrounding neighborhoods.

WHY

Hillside Pool/Lions Park is one of Bismarck Park and Recreation District's oldest community parks, located on the east side of Bismarck. The park was created in 1938 and is a destination for residents and visitors alike. The infrastructure and recreation elements are now aging and are in need of renovation, not only for aesthetic purposes, but also to sustain the park environment and elements for the future.

WHEN

The renovations and improvements to Hillside Pool/Lions Park are currently underway and will be made in three phases, ending in 2012.
