

## **BISMARCK PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT 3rd GRADE YOUTH VOLLEYBALL PROGRAM**

The purpose of the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade youth volleyball program is to teach basic volleyball skills, fundamentals and sportsmanship. Participants will learn through practices and scrimmage games on Saturdays. The season begins January 27<sup>th</sup> and ends on Saturday, March 21<sup>st</sup>. Each team will practice one day per week. All practices and games will be held at the World War Memorial Building (215 N 6<sup>th</sup> St). Teams will be arranged by schools and some schools may be combined.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Practices are scheduled to begin January 27<sup>th</sup>, provided a volunteer coach has been identified. **If we do not have a volunteer coach at this time, you will be notified.**

- Practices are once per week for one hour.
- We will attempt to organize teams by school. Maximum of 13 players per team.
- Game schedules will be distributed on or by February 3<sup>rd</sup> at 5pm.
- Games will be played Saturday mornings at the World War Memorial Building on February 8, 15, 22, 29, March 7, and Jamboree on March 20 and 21.
- T-shirts will be distributed at practice the week of February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please wear shirts to all games.

- Please have participants dress comfortably (shorts or sweats) and wear tennis shoes.

- Only coaches, scorekeepers, officials and players are allowed on the main level during games. All spectators must sit in the bleachers/balcony on game days.
