



## American Legion Class A Baseball Information Sheet

### Player Fees

- The player fee is \$450 per player. Each player will be responsible to sell ten raffle tickets.

### Team Make Up

- Two teams: one 16-year-old team and one 16 – 19-year-old team
- Three teams: one 16-year-old team and two even 16 – 19-year-old teams OR one 16-year-old team, one class A 16 – 19-year-old teams, and one class B 16 – 19-year-old teams

### Practices and Games

- The goal is to schedule 22 to 30 games in a season (not including tournaments).
- Practices will last around 2 hours.
  - Tryouts and practices start in June, after the high school state tournament
  - Practice times: In the morning or early afternoon
  - Practices will not be held on day of games.
  - All practices, games, schedules, times and locations are subject to change.
  - Rained out games will be rescheduled, if possible.

  - The coaches will communicate any schedule changes to the players, and the changes will be posted at [www.bgovs.org](http://www.bgovs.org).
  - BPRD will try to provide busing to all away games. If a bus drive cannot be found parents or guardian will be responsible for providing travel to that game or tournament.

### Tournaments

- There are one- two tournaments planned for the regular season.
- West Region
  - Location: Mandan

- State Tournament
  - Location: Kindred
  - Dates: July 28-Aug. 1
