Player Fees

• The player fee is an \$450 per player. Each player will be responsible to sell 20 raffle tickets.

Practices and Games

-The goal is to schedule 34 to 40 games in a season (not including tournaments).

- Practices will last 2-3 hours.
 - Tryouts & practices start in June, after the high school state tournament
 - Practice time mid-morning
 - Practices will not be held on day of games.
 - Games will be played on July 3 and 4 in Mandan.
 - All practices, games, schedules, times, and locations are subject to change.
 - Rained out games will be rescheduled, if possible.
