MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS May 17, 2018

The Board of Park Commissioners held their regular meeting on May 17, 2018 in the Tom Baker meeting room of the City/County Building. President Munson called the meeting to order at 5:15 pm. Commissioners Jeske, Schwartz, Beattie and President Munson were present.

Commissioner Beattie moved to approve the agenda with the removal of item #4 – Dan Schaefer with the Metro Ambulance Service. Commissioner Jeske seconded the motion and the voting went as follows: Ayes: Commissioners Jeske, Schwartz, Beattie and President Munson. The nays being none, the motion carried.

Evan Sayler, a Century High School cross country athlete appeared before the Board as a Featured Partner and Program. He was named ND's Cross County Gatorage Player of the Year and chose Bismarck Parks and Recreation District to receive a grant as part of the Gatorade Play it Forward Initiative.

Deputy Chief Randy Ziegler from the city of Bismarck Police Department was the other Featured Partner and Program. He spoke about the partnership between the Bismarck Police Department and Bismarck Parks and Recreation District.

Laura Pitcher appeared before the Board to make a presentation on the need for additional indoor tennis court space in the Bismarck-Mandan community.

Jeff Ubl from Ubl Design provided a summary of the bids received for the New Generations Park project. Commissioner Jeske moved to award the following bids for a total of \$1,347,170.
