

## **EQUIPMENT**



- Metal Spikes = OK
- Infielders and catchers should wear a protective cup
- We will provide catcher's gear and batting helmets but:
  - We highly recommend to purchase a helmet: Easton Z5 Grip navy batting helmet
  - No Chrome on catcher's gear and batting helmets
  - Any shared equipment has an inherent risk of using it
    - All shared equipment will be sanitized at end of day



#### APPROVED BATS

#### 13-15 Baseball Division

- The bat may not exceed 34" in length, and the bat barrel may not exceed 2 5/8" in diameter.
- All aluminum/alloy barrel bats and all composite handle (only) aluminum/alloy BBCOR .50 barrels are allowed.
- Only composite barrel bats certified and marked USA Baseball Marking will be allowed.
- Wood barrel bats conforming to the specifications of Official Baseball Rule 1.10 are allowed.

#### • How will I know which bat to buy?

 All new bats that bear the USABat licensing mark will be permissible for play in the leagues and tournaments of the participating youth baseball organizations.



#### BATS NOT APPROVED

 Tampering or altering bats may violate certain federal and state laws and voids the USA Baseball certification, as well as all manufacturer warranties. Rolling is considered tampering and would void the bat's certification and make it illegal for play.

# LEAGUE STRUCTURE & TEAM FORMATION CRITERIA

#### League Format

- The league will be separated into Major and Minor Leagues. Players will only play in one league.
- Major (Travel Baseball):
  - The Major league consists of 13's, 14's, and 15's advancing teams and a 13-15 non-advancing team.
- Minor (League Baseball):
  - The Minor league will consist of player ages 13-15 league teams.



# LEAGUE STRUCTURE & TEAM FORMATION CRITERIA

- Team selection process
- Balance teams as equally as possible
  - Major league teams will consist of same team rosters of extra baseball teams.
- Carpooling requests –NOT Guaranteed
  - Due last day of league tryouts
  - Request forms found at tryouts
- 12-15 players per team
- There will be NO CUTTING of players.



#### MINOR LEAGUE

- Minor League Tryouts Tatley Eagles Park
  - Age 13 at South Field and Ages 14 & 15 at North Field
  - May 11:6 7:30pm
  - May 12: 6 7:30pm

All players will be placed on a team!

\*No Parents at league tryouts!!!

-Unless you're a head coach

Players only need to come to one try-out date

-We use scores to make teams





#### MINOR LEAGUE

- Practice times:
  - May 19-21, Tuesday-Thursday
    - 4:30-5:30pm, 5:30-6:30pm, 6:30-7:30pm and 7:30-8:30pm
    - Teams rotate practice times
- Practice times and lengths may change depending on how many teams are in the league
- No Baseball May 25th Memorial Day



#### MINOR LEAGUE

- Starting May 26
  - Minor practices scheduled for Tuesday and Thursdays
    - 4:30 p.m., 5:30 p.m., 6:30p.m. or 7:30 p.m.
    - Teams rotate practice times
  - Minor games scheduled to begin Mondays and Wednesdays
    - 4:30 p.m. or 6:45 p.m.
- Game and Practices
  - Tatley North and South, Municipal Ball Park, Haaland Field, and BPS Sport Complex (Legacy).
- Schedules subject to change
- Practice times and lengths may change depending on how many teams are in the league



## MAJOR LEAGUE INFORMATION



### MAJOR LEAGUE: TRAVEL BASEBALL

- Players commit to more than league play
- 13, 14, & 15 year old advancing teams and a 13-15 year old non-advancing team if enough interest and coaches.
- 12 player min/15 player max per team
- Games played vs Minot, Williston, Mandan, Dickinson, Jamestown, West Fargo, + 2 to 3 tournaments
- Parents are responsible for players transportation, meals, and lodging for all games including Invitational, State, Regional, and World Series Tournaments.



### MAJOR LEAGUE

- Major League Tryouts Tatley Eagles Park
  - Age 13 at South Field and Ages 14 & 15 at North Field
  - May 6: First All Star Tryout: 6 7:30pm
  - May 10: 2 3:30PM
  - May 13: 6 7:30pm
    - \*No Parents at tryouts!!!
    - \* Players need to come to all three tryouts!





# MAJOR LEAGUE

- Practices
  - There will be practices scheduled in the evenings during May 19-22
  - Starting May 26<sup>th</sup> practices will be in the mornings and early afternoons at:
    - Tatley North/South Park (Airport Road and Michigan Avenue) or Haaland Field (South 12th St.).
  - Major season practice times/days will be provided at the end of tryouts.
- Games
  - Games will be played throughout the week and weekends
    - Schedules will be posted as soon as they are done
  - Tatley North and South, Municipal Ball Park, Haaland Field, and BPS Sport Complex (Legacy).
- All schedules are subject to change and will change throughout the season.

#### MAJOR LEAGUE EXTRA FEES

- Major League Fees = additional games/tournament
  - Advancing = \$165 per player (includes State Tourney & beyond)
  - Non-advancing = \$90 per player (up to State Tourney)
  - Due after tryout
- Major league fees will be collected after Major tryouts.

- Each Major participant will also be <u>required</u> to sell <u>5 raffle tickets</u> at \$20 per raffle ticket for \$100.
