Project Development:



Sattler Homes approached BPRD and asked for permission to develop the property into a park, and also offered to pay for the park features. The Board of Park Commissioners approved the request for the park to be designed and constructed to Park District standards and specifications. Sattler Homes moved forward with the park development at their own expense. The park includes the features listed below.

- Playground structure for all ages
- Swings and sand diggers
- Continuation of the Southland Trail, which is nearly one mile of paved trail through the Southland neighborhood
- Basketball court
- Trees
