

Major League Non-Advancing (NA) Baseball Info Sheet

Player Fees

• The extra player fee for Major League is \$100 per player. Each player will be responsible to sell 10 raffle tickets.

Practices and Games

-The goal is to schedule 16 to 20 games in a season (not including tournaments).

- Practices will last a 1 ½ hours.
 - Practices start May 22
 - Starting May 30 to end of season: NA (Bombers) will practice M-F from 10:30am to 12 pm at Tatley-Eagles Park, NA (Express) will practice M-F from 12 pm to 1:30 pm at Tatley-Eagles Park.
 - Practices will not be held on game days.
 - Practices will not be held on May 29 or July 1-4
 - All practices, games, schedules, times, and locations are subject to change.
 - Rained out games will be rescheduled, if possible.
 - Schedules will be posted at <u>www.bisparks.org</u>.
 - The coaches will communicate any schedule changes to the players, and the changes will be posted at <u>www.bisparks.org</u>.
 - Parents/guardians are responsible for all travel to and from all practices, games, and tournaments.

Tournaments

• Team(s) will go to a minimum of one tournament.

End of Season

- Teams will play in a non-advancing state tournament if one is hosted.
- If there is no non-advancing state tournament, teams will play in the Fargo Youth Baseball NIT July 28-30 for this year 2023.

Parent involvement

- Volunteers are needed to help guide and supervise players in the dugout during games. All volunteers must complete an application, background check, and complete any required certifications.
- Team Manager: help send information to parents and help find workers to help in press box during home games and any local tournaments.
- A parent coach will be allowed if there is a shortage of coaches. Parents will have to apply for the position.
