## **BISMARCK PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT 2021 SUMMER SOCCER PROGRAM**

### **GENERAL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

- ◆ The Summer Soccer Program meets twice a week, with each age group meeting for an hour each night. **The team rosters will be posted at the site on the first day of soccer.** Team shirts and game schedules will be distributed on June 16 & 17. Starting June 21 & 22, coaches will teach fundamentals for the first 10-15 minutes with the remaining time used for games. Although games are played, win-loss records are not kept and coaches are instructed to play each participant equally. Coaches provide all of the officiating during the games. Participants receive participation ribbons at the completion of the program.

### **GOALS OF PROGRAM**

- ◆ To teach fundamentals of soccer
- ◆ Equal participation
- ◆ Development of skills
- ◆ Fun
- ◆ Safety of participant

### **AGE GROUPS SERVED**

- ◆ This program is offered to participants in Grades K-9 (grade entering this fall).
- ◆ Teams are coed and are split up by the following grades:
  - ◆ K-1                      2-3                      4-6                      7-9

### **LENGTH OF PROGRAM**

- ◆ This is an eight-week program beginning June 7 and concluding on July 29.
- ◆ **No soccer on July 1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>.**
- ◆ Cottonwood participants meet on Mondays and Wednesdays for one hour.
- ◆ Horizon participants meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays for one hour.
- ◆ Grades K-3 meet from 6:30 pm-7:30 pm; Grades 4-9 meet 7:45 pm-8:45pm

### **LOCATION OF PROGRAM/ORGANIZATION OF FIELDS**

- ◆ Participants register to play at the Cottonwood Park Soccer Complex or Horizon Middle School, depending on where you live: play at Cottonwood if you live south of Divide Ave and at Horizon if you live north of Divide Avenue.
- ◆ Micro fields (60 x 90) are used for grades K-1 participants.
- ◆ 150 x 270 fields and 205 x 315 fields are used for grades 2-6 participants.
- ◆ 205 x 315 fields are used for grades 7-9 participants

### **TEAM INFORMATION**

- ◆ Teams will be balanced equally, based on registration numbers, whenever possible.
- ◆ Teammate requests are taken into consideration, but are not guaranteed. **Submit teammate requests to the park office (400 E. Front Ave.) by May 28; any requests submitted after May 28 will not be accepted.** Teammate request forms can be found on the [www.bisparks.org](http://www.bisparks.org) website.

## STAFFING

- ◆ This program is directed by Jeremy Dykstra, Facility Specialist with BPRD.
- ◆ There is a Site Supervisor at each location.
- ◆ Coaches
  - ◆ Hiring begins in late April, until all positions are filled.
  - ◆ **IF YOU WANT TO COACH, PLEASE SUBMIT A COMPLETED JOB APPLICATION ASAP. WE NEED YOU!**
  - ◆ Coaches receive a Coach's Manual and guidelines regarding program goals at a pre-season meeting.
  - ◆ Each coach is issued a Park District shirt to wear while coaching.

## EQUIPMENT

- ◆ **Participants are required to purchase and wear shin guards.**
- ◆ Players must provide their own sunscreen and water bottles. THESE ITEMS ARE STRONGLY SUGGESTED!
- ◆ Soccer balls in various sizes (3, 4, 5) are provided as appropriate for the age group.
- ◆ Cones, nets and first aid supplies are provided.
