- Be available to meet the team at the team check in
- Cheer the team on during their games
- Be the “go to” person for the coaches, players, and parents, should they have any questions or need assistance with all things Bismarck, such as like:
 - Places to eat
 - Things to do or activities on their day off
- Treat these players like part of your family!

Additional ideas that are nice, but not necessary, include

- Have a picnic for your team
- Supply drinks and/or snacks before or after the game
- Wash uniforms
